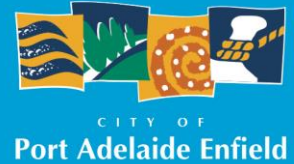


# RESIDENTIAL BUILDING REBATE Application Form

Rates are still due and payable by the due date pending a decision of your rebate application.
