HOLIDAY SAFETY



Holidays are a time to relax, visit family and friends and spend time outdoors. Whether you are staying in a hotel, motel, hostel, caravan park or a campsite, please consider the following safety and security tips to enjoy your holidays.

ACCOMMODATION SECURITY

- Be aware of your new surroundings and take note of emergency plans.
- Ensure all doors and windows are locked, even when going out for a short time.
- Secure valuable items in a safe. If there is no safe, take them with you.
- Take your keys with you. Do not hide them.

WATER ACTIVITIES

- Be aware of your new surroundings and take note of emergency plans.
- Ensure all doors and windows are locked, even when going out for a short time.
- Secure valuable items in a safe. If there is no safe, take them with you.
- Take your keys with you. Do not hide them.

ROAD SAFETY

- Plan your trip. Drive on major roads and don't take shortcuts.
- Make sure your vehicle is road worthy and you have sufficient fuel.
- Interstate and overseas visitors must carry a current driver's licence when driving in South Australia.
- Always drive with your doors locked.
- Never pick up hitchhikers.
- In Australia, you must drive on the left-hand side of the road.
- When driving long distances, share the driving and stop for at least 15 minutes every two hours.
- On open roads the speed limit in South Australia is 100 km/h unless otherwise signposted.
- In built-up areas the speed limit in South Australia is 50 km/h unless otherwise signposted.

BE SAFE AND SECURE THIS CHRISTMAS



Christmas is the season of shopping, receiving deliveries, and storing gifts. It's also the season for opportunistic thieves to steal them. South Australia Police encourage you to follow these crime prevention tips to help keep your gifts secure this Christmas

At home:

- Avoid placing gifts under a Christmas tree that is visible from the street.
- Record serial numbers, descriptions and take photos of your most valuable gifts.
- Keep sales receipts away from the gift file them in a secure place.
- If you have to store gifts in sheds or a garage, make sure they are kept locked.
- Use a lockable letterbox to avoid mail theft and if you're expecting a delivery, ensure someone will be home or arrange to collect it from the Post Office or courier depot.
- Break down the packaging of large or expensive gifts and place them inside the rubbish bin only put the bins out on collection day.




