MANDATE FOR NEGLECTED CHILD TO BE SENT TO AN INSTITUTION.

[PURSUANT TO "THE STATE CHILDREN ACT, 1895."]

To William Raymond, Esquire, Commissioner of Police, and all Constables, in the State of South Australia, and to The Mayor of the Industrial School at Edwardstown.

WHEREAS Etta, a girl, has been brought before the undersigned, Justice of the Peace, in and for the State of South Australia and charged with being a neglected child within the meaning of "The State Children Act, 1895," in that she is under the guardianship of a person, to wit an Aborigine woman named Lucy who is unfit to have such guardianship.

AND whereas we have heard the matter of the said charge, and are satisfied that the said Etta is in fact a neglected child within the meaning of the said Act, and have convicted her thereof accordingly: AND whereas the said Etta is of the age of about five years months, and of the religion: AND whereas we have ordered the said Etta to be sent to The Industrial School at Edwardstown, to be there detained or otherwise dealt with under the said Act until she attains the age of eighteen years.

THESE are to require to whom this mandate is directed, to take the said Etta to the said institution, and there to deliver her to the Mayor thereof, together with the duplicate of this mandate: AND the said Mayor is hereby required to receive the said child into the said school, there to be detained or otherwise dealt with under the said Act until the expiration of the term aforesaid, unless she shall in the meantime be discharged in due course of law.
