Online Grant Application System

We provide an online application tool to help you prepare and submit your application. Support or access to computers and the internet can be provided if required. Community Grants

Partnerships

Partnership Grant program is to support the delivery of significant projects that improve community wellbeing. Projects should demonstrate the collaboration of key stakeholders and be delivered through partnership between the funded organisation(s) and Council. We are particularly interested to see applications that improve our community's social connections, safety and/or foster a welcoming city. Grants of up to \$25,000 per year will be considered. Only projects with exceptional merit will be awarded full funding amount. All agreements will initially be for 1 year. Closing dates will be displayed on the Council website. Applicants moving through to the next stage will be invited to put forward a more detailed proposal. Proposals will be considered by Council's Grants & Sponsorship Committee, with input from Council staff.

Projects

Project Grants of up to \$7,500 aim to support the delivery of a broad range of projects that support community health and wellbeing. Applications may be submitted when the funding round opens. We have two assessment rounds per year. Closing dates will be displayed on the Council website. We are looking to fund projects that can demonstrate positive outcomes for the community.

Equipment

Equipment Grants of up to \$2,000 per year are available to not-for-profit groups and organisations to purchase equipment which is urgent or necessary for the organisation to deliver activities or services which foster individual and community wellbeing. Applications may be submitted at any time during the year and will receive a response within 4 weeks. Unincorporated community groups can apply for Equipment Grants without the need for an auspice.

Small

Grants of up to \$1,000 are available for not-for-profit groups and organisations for unforeseen or short-notice projects that provide health & wellbeing services or benefits to the local community. Applications may be submitted at any time during the year and will receive a response within 4 weeks. Unincorporated community groups can apply for Small Grants without the need for an auspice.

Sport & Recreation Grants

Grants of up to \$1,000 are available for activities and purchases that clearly encourage active lifestyles in the local community and deliver on one or more key areas of focus. We have two assessment rounds per year in March and September however, if you can demonstrate why your application is urgent and should be assessed outside of this, please contact us to discuss.

Placemaking Grants

At the City of PAE we are committed to making our city a place where people love to be, so we offer the PAE Places Grants to help develop community spaces. PAE Places Grants can be used to improve how we feel and use our public spaces and how we can enhance the way they look and work, and also how we celebrate our heritage

<u>Grand Vision Grants</u> of \$1,000 - \$3,000 will be available for community organisations and businesses with an ABN. Intimate Inspiration Grants of \$500 - \$1,000 will be available for individuals or informal groups without an ABN.

Individual Grants

If you are a resident of the PAE Council you can apply for an Individual Grant of \$200 to assist you to participate in significant activities or opportunities. The opportunity should support your participation in a significant personal growth or personal development opportunity and as a consequence provide ongoing promotion and support for the PAE Community. Applications may be submitted at any time during the year and will receive a response within 4 weeks. Some examples of eligible activities include the following but are not limited to:

- Selection in a national or international level competition;
- Recommended for participation in Youth Parliament;
- Recommended for participation in Youth Adventure Day Sails;
- Selection in a unique art festival, exhibition or competition for an emerging artist;
- Recommended for participation in workshops or conferences that will develop the artist's skills to deliver community benefit outcomes.

Event Grants

This grant aims to support the development of vibrant, creative and innovative events that enhance the economic, social and cultural life of our City and give increased support to events that build the public profile of our City.

Major Events

Major Events may receive up to \$12,000 to support events to be held in the City of PAE attracting more than 8000 attendees on any one day, and that will deliver significant and measureable economic benefit to the City of PAE. The sponsorship aims to support a changing program of vibrant, creative and innovative events, increase tourist visitation to the City of PAE, support economic growth in the City of PAE, facilitate community participation in and enjoyment of a diverse range of events and build partnerships that increase recognition of Council's role in the creation of a City where people love to be.

General Events

General Events may receive up to \$5,000 to support events to be held in the City of PAE attracting between 1000 – 8000 attendees on any one day. Eligible events should be able to establish partnerships to achieve recognition for the City; increase tourist visitation to the City; deliver measurable economic benefits to the City and facilitate community involvement in events and activities.

Minor Community Events

Minor Community Events may receive up to \$750 to assist with the cost of holding local community events with a limited expected attendance (less than 1,000 people).

Disability Access Grants for Small Businesses

This grant aims to assist local small businesses in the PAE region to improve access to their building by people who have a disability. In turn, providing support for the repurposing of older buildings to preserve history, whilst encouraging new economic activity. Any approved grant is provided as a reimbursement of 50% of the completed project costs up to a maximum of \$5,000.

Heritage Grants

Council's Heritage Grant seeks to encourage owners of Local Heritage Places and Contributory Items to maintain, conserve or restore places of local significance. Depending on the demand for assistance and funds available for the respective financial year, a maximum of 50% of the value of completed work, not to exceed \$3,000 in any one financial year may be approved. As part of this grant, Council's Heritage Advisor can assist owners of Local or Contributory properties by providing advice regarding the eligibility of proposed works. An onsite meeting with Council's Heritage Advisor is strongly recommended prior to submitting any application.
