

Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Awards 2022 Nomination Form



Introduction

The City of Port Adelaide Enfield is proud to acknowledge and celebrate our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and their contribution to our community.

Each year Council seeks nominations from members of the community and community organisations for the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander (ATSI) Awards. The Awards are presented at a special event hosted by Council and the Aboriginal Advisory Panel.

Recipients of the City of Port Adelaide Enfield ATSI Awards may be nominated by Council for the State and/or National NAIDOC Week Awards.

Award Categories

Categories for the Awards in 2022 are:

- Elder of the Year
- Aunty Josie Agius Youth Achievement Award
- Person of the Year
- Sports Person of the Year
- Contribution to the Arts
- Educational Achievement
- Lifetime Achievement
- Recognition of an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Island group or organisation for its contribution to the Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander community
- Recognition of a non-Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person, group or organisation for their contribution to the Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander community.

Nomination Process

In order for a nomination to be accepted, the selection criteria must be addressed in the nomination form.

Each nomination must be submitted on a separate nomination form.

Nominees will be required to have their photo taken for the ATSI Awards 2022 booklet. Council will contact nominees to arrange a time to take photographs after their nomination is received.

Eligibility

The nominee must:

- Be of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent (living or passed) *
**This criterion does not apply for the 'Recognition of a non-Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person, group or organisation for their contribution to the community' Award.*
- Reside or have a significant involvement in the Port Adelaide Enfield community (for example, they play sport, go to school or work in the area).

Selection Criteria

The awards selection process is determined by the City of Port Adelaide Enfield Council Guidelines *CD.GL.02 Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Awards*.

Nominations will be assessed against the Eligibility and Selection Criteria which are outlined in the nomination form.

Council will assess nominees on the following criteria:

- Demonstrated excellence in their nominated category;
- The individual's status as an inspirational role model for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and the broader Australian population;
- Demonstrated leadership;
- Achievements which result in an ongoing benefit to the community;
- Demonstrated commitment to personal/vocational/career development.

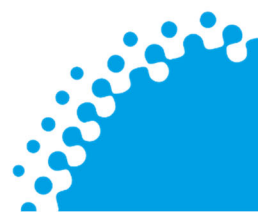

Nomination Categories

Please select one category only. Each nomination must be submitted on a separate Nomination Form

☐ **Elder of the Year**

Elder of the Year will be awarded to an individual who symbolises the values important to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and is an inspirational leader and a role model for others. Nominees should demonstrate commitment, contribution and achievements that benefit Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people over the long term, resulting in an ongoing benefit to the community.

☐ **Aunty Josie Agius Youth Achievement Award**

Nominees for the Aunty Josie Agius Youth Achievement Award must be aged between 12-25 years of age. The winner of this award will be chosen for their outstanding contribution to their community and/or excellence in their chosen field and will be regarded as an inspirational role model for other young people.

☐ **Person of the Year**

The Person of the Year will be awarded to an individual who demonstrates excellence in their chosen field, has made an outstanding contribution and be regarded as an inspirational role model by others. Nominees will have made significant impact in the Port Adelaide Enfield community, through professional OR voluntary undertakings.

☐ **Sports Person of the Year**

Sports Person of the Year will be awarded to an individual who has achieved excellence in their sporting field, displaying leadership, sportsmanship and is an inspirational role model for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and the broader Port Adelaide Enfield community.

☐ **Contribution to the Arts**

Nominees for the Contribution to the Arts Award may be an individual involved in any visual or performing arts medium, including musicians, writers, performers, designers and other visual arts. Nominees should be recognised as an inspirational role model, demonstrate commitment and achievement in their chosen field and contribute to the cultural life of Port Adelaide Enfield.

☐ **Educational Achievement**

The Educational Achievement Award will be awarded to an individual who demonstrates excellence and achievement in secondary and/or tertiary study and is an inspirational role model for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and the broader Port Adelaide Enfield community.

☐ **Lifetime Achievement**

The Lifetime Achievement Award will be awarded to an individual who is worthy of being recognised as legendary, is an inspirational role model, and demonstrates leadership. The winner will demonstrate commitment, and contribution and achievements to that benefit Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people over the long term, demonstrated achievements and involvement in the community resulting in an ongoing benefit to the community.

☐ **Recognition of an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander group or organisation for its contribution to the community**

This winner of this award will be a group or organisation that demonstrates excellence in cultural service delivery, community engagement and has provided significant contribution to the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community. The group or organisation should demonstrate service outputs that are likely to have an ongoing benefit for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and the broader City of Port Adelaide Enfield population.

☐ **Recognition of a non-Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person, group or organisation for their contribution to the community**

This winner of this award will be a non-Aboriginal person, group or organisation that has provided significant contribution to the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community. Nominees should demonstrate that their achievements or service outputs are likely to have an ongoing benefit for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and the broader City of Port Adelaide Enfield population.

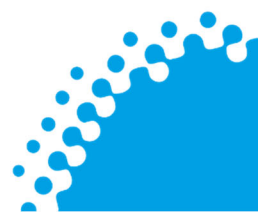
