## Instructions:

- This form is for landowners objecting to a fencing notice served on them by Council to initiate fencing works (and apply for a reimbursement from Council), use Form No. 2
- This form is not to obtain approval for <u>fences classed as development under the Development Act</u>. Use the <u>development application form</u> for fences that are development.
- Council's <u>Fencing Cost Reimbursements</u> provides further guidance in filling this form
