Online Grant Application System

Before submitting online you will need to register with SmartyGrants using an email address, please visit <https://CityofPAE.smartygrants.com.au> and select *Log in* at the top of the page. This will direct you to the webpage where you can either register by creating an account or log in using an existing account. Once you are logged in you can select from the list of current rounds, the grant program you wish to apply for. Please ensure you know which grant you need to apply for, as applying for a grant through the wrong category may delay your notification. If you are unsure which grant to apply for please contact our Grants Team on 8405 6882, or email grants@cityofpae.sa.gov.au. You will then be taken to the *Before you Begin* page, which will have important information that will help you through the process of submitting a grant application. Please read this, then select *Fill Out Now* button located at the top of the page. This will take you to the application form where you can commence your application. There is an option *Preview the form* should you wish to see the form before you commence.

Community Grants

These grants are looking to fund projects and partnerships that help us achieve our City Plan 2030 with a primary focus on 'A City that supports community wellbeing'

Community Partnerships

Partnership Grants support the delivery of significant projects that improve community health & wellbeing. Projects should demonstrate the collaboration of key stakeholders and be delivered through a partnership between the funded organisation(s) and Council. Grants of up to \$25,000 per year will be considered. Funding for up to 3 years may be available if there is a clear need for longer term funding to achieve successful outcomes. Partnership Grants will be open annually with an initial call for Expressions of Interest (EOI). Closing dates will be displayed on the Council website. Applicants moving through to the next stage will be invited to put forward a more detailed proposal. Proposals will be considered by Council's Grants & Sponsorship Committee, with input from Council staff. The information provided in the EOI will also be included in your assessment for your full application.

Community Projects

Project Grants of up to \$7,500 aim to support the delivery of a broad range of projects that support community health and wellbeing. Applications may be submitted at any time, with four selection rounds per year. Closing dates will be displayed on the Council website. We are looking to fund projects that align with our City Plan and can demonstrate positive outcomes for the community.

Equipment

Equipment Grants of up to \$2,000 per year are available to not-for-profit groups and organisations to purchase equipment which supports them to deliver services to the community. Applications may be submitted at any time during the year and will receive a response within 4 weeks. Unincorporated community groups can apply for Equipment Grants.

Small Grants

Grants of up to \$1,000 are available for not-for-profit groups and organisations for unforeseen or short-notice projects that provide services or benefits to the local community. Applications may be submitted at any time during the year and will receive a response within 4 weeks. Unincorporated community groups can apply for Small Grants.

Individual Grants

If you are a resident of the Port Adelaide Enfield Council you can apply for an Individual Grant of \$200 to assist you to participate in significant activities or opportunities. The opportunity should support your participation in a significant personal growth or personal development opportunity and as a consequence provide ongoing promotion and support for the City of Port Adelaide Enfield Community. Applications may be submitted at any time during the year and will receive a response within 4 weeks. Some examples of eligible activities include the following but are not limited to:

- Selection in a national or international level competition;
- Recommended for participation in Youth Parliament;
- Recommended for participation in Youth Adventure Day Sails;
- Selection in a unique art festival, exhibition or competition for an emerging artist;
- Recommended for participation in workshops or conferences that will develop the artist's skills to deliver community benefit outcomes.

Sporting Club Grants

Sporting Clubs and/or Sporting Organisations that provide structured sport for young people under 18 years of age can apply to purchase sporting equipment and uniforms. Applications can also be received where five or more residents are participating in the same competition at an Interstate, National or International level of competition. Eligible applicants can apply for up to \$750 once in any twelve month period.

Event Grants

This grant aims to support the development of vibrant, creative and innovative events that enhance the economic, social and cultural life of our City and give increased support to events that build the public profile of our City.

Major Events

Major Events may receive up to \$12,000 to support events to be held in the City of PAE attracting more than 8000 attendees on any one day, and that will deliver significant and measureable economic benefit to the City of PAE. The sponsorship aims to support a changing program of vibrant, creative and innovative events, increase tourist visitation to the City of PAE, support economic growth in the City of PAE, facilitate community participation in and enjoyment of a diverse range of events and build partnerships that increase recognition of Council's role in the creation of a City where people love to be.

General Events

General Events may receive up to \$5,000 to support events to be held in the City of PAE attracting between 1000 – 8000 attendees on any one day. Eligible events should be able to establish partnerships to achieve recognition for the City; increase tourist visitation to the City; deliver measurable economic benefits to the City and facilitate community involvement in events and activities.

Minor Community Events

Minor Community Events may receive up to \$750 to assist with the cost of holding local community events with a limited expected attendance (less than 1,000 people).

Disability Access Grants for Small Businesses

This is a pilot grant program to assist local small businesses in the Port Adelaide Commercial precinct (as outlined in the Guidelines) to improve access to their building by people who have a disability. With many older and heritage buildings within the Port Adelaide Commercial precinct, this aims to encourage the repurposing of older buildings to preserve history, whilst encouraging new economic activity. Any approved grant is provided as a reimbursement of 50% of the completed project costs up to a maximum of \$5,000.

PAE Places Grants

PAE Places is a placemaking grant program to support City of Port Adelaide Enfield (PAE) communities and businesses to create and deliver projects in public spaces across the city. It aims to give the community the opportunity to make their City a place where people love to be through placemaking projects of all sizes and shapes. PAE Places grants provide an opportunity for community members to put ideas for how to improve the vitality of the local area into practice, resulting in local activity, a strong sense of place and greater community cohesion. PAE Places Grand Vision Grants of between \$1000 - \$5000 will be available for community organisations and businesses with an ABN. We may allocate a small number of larger grants (up to \$7500) for exceptional projects that we believe can be scaled up. PAE Places Intimate Inspirations Grants of \$500 - \$1000 will be available for individuals or informal groups without an ABN.

Heritage Grants

Council's Heritage Grant seeks to encourage owners of Local Heritage Places and Contributory Items to maintain, conserve or restore places of local significance. Depending on the demand for assistance and funds available for the respective financial year, a maximum of 50% of the value of completed work, not to exceed \$3,000 in any one financial year may be approved. As part of this Grant, Council's Heritage Advisor can assist owners of Local or Contributory properties by providing advice regarding the eligibility of proposed works. An onsite meeting with Council's Heritage Advisor is strongly recommended prior to submitting any application.
